



Implementing Institutional Change in University Lifelong Learning (ULLL)

Face-to-face workshop

The objectives of this workshop are to identify the main drivers for change in universities and explore how these impact on ULLL, to consider the different structures of ULLL between universities and what the consequences of these structures are for implementing change in ULLL, to identify the real practical changes being made in universities in ULLL and finally, to explore evaluating change in ULLL and consider how this might differ from existing approaches.

This workshop gives you the opportunity to:

1. **share your experiences** about the main changes and drivers affecting ULLL
2. **explore** your own universities' and general weaknesses and strengths in implementing ULLL
3. start **discussions** about various approaches on how to implement ULLL

PRELIMINARY PROGRAMME:

14:30 – 15:30 **Activity 1:** What are the reasons for change in ULLL? The opening activity identifies the main drivers for change in order to gauge what impacts they will have on universities and lifelong learning.

15:30 – 16:15 **Activity 2:** Who is responsible for implementing change in ULLL? This activity considers the different types of internal organisational structures used for the delivery of ULLL and compares their inherent strengths and weaknesses.

16:30 – 17:30 **Activity 3:** What changes are being made to implement ULLL? This activity examines the breadth of changes that are actually being made in universities in response to external drivers for change in ULLL.

17:30 – 18:00 **Activity 4:** Evaluating changes in ULLL. This final activity identifies how important it is to monitor and evaluate changes in ULLL and consider how this may require different approaches to those that currently exist in universities. Time space of 10 min. for evaluation sheet (activity of all participants)
