The history of a vision - translated into projects

- BeFlex (2005 April 2007)
 - Survey the state of play in ULLL in relations to the Bologna Reform (collect 50 case studies, visit 20 universities)
- BeFlex Plus (Oct 2007 Sept 2009)
 - Survey update on state of play
 - Follow-up case studies from BeFlex and collect new case studies
 - Printed training manual on 5 topics reladet to ULLL









The history of a vision - Translated into projects

IMPLEMENT (Jan 2011 – Dec 2012)

- Collect 2 new case studies
- Adapt training materials to specific needs
- Organise training events in institutional, national, transnational and trans-sectoral context
- Develop sustainable online-tools









Embedding of results

- Continuity and development over time with EC funding support
- Real engagement from partners
- Concrete but also flexible training materials to act on the recommendations
- Importance of institutional and national context
- Real training events for stimulating and promoting embedding at different levels and follow-up resources









Method

- BeFlexPlus / IMPLEMENT could be a model for how to embed a LLL Strategy
- Particularly a good method for integrating all actors in a "bottom-up"-process (c.f. evaluation of IMPLEMENT-Workshops)
- IMPLEMENT follows a "Quality cycle" (using materials, making a critical review, improving the materials and adapt them to the institutional context and so on...)









Method

- A Case Study is a helpful instrument:
 - It's concrete, short, practically orientated and thereby clearly arranged
- But... you maybe have to "translate" or "transform" it later in the process into an academic strategic paper on LLL

- How can we combine and use the results of all projects together in an integrated way – synthesis?
- What can institutions do? How to change institutional attitudes to their projects and their strategic use?
